LOCATION

Cadaver Workshop - 5th April (Registered Delegates only FULL CAPACITY):

Queens Medical Centre School of Life Sciences Room E143, Medical School Derby Road Nottingham NG7 2UH

The Anatomy Teaching Suite is based on E floor of the Medical School within the University of Nottingham QMC site. E floor can be accessed directly by using the lifts in West Block by the Main Entrance to QMC or via the South Block lifts. Alternatively, the Medical School has its own set of lifts by the Medical School Main Entrance. The location of the lab is highlighted in red on the floor plan of the Medical School site.

Car parking is available in Carpark 3 @ £6.00 for the day, or there is tram that runs from the city centre to the QMC, which is £ 3.70 for a day ticket and a ticket can be purchased at the tram stop.

PRESENTATION UPLOADS

Are you presenting a podium presentation?

All accepted presenters will already have been notified by email and are now listed in the programme. There will be a minimum of 6 abstracts presented in each section. All podium presentations will be strictly limited to 6 minutes with 4 minutes Q&A. Special poster presentations will be strictly limited to 3 minutes with 2 minutes Q&As.

Upon arrival at the Nottingham Conference Centre, please head straight to the registration desk located on level 1 to pick-up your name badge. From there you will be directed to the AV team in the Green Room who will upload your presentation from a memory stick to the show laptop. Please arrive no less than 2 hours prior to your presentation time.

Are you presenting a poster presentation?

As part of your acceptance, you or a co-author, **MUST** be present at the refreshment breaks in order to answer any questions from the marking team.

POSTER GUIDANCE

- Each poster must be maximum AO size (not exceeding 841mm (33") wide x 1189mm (46.8") high).
- > Each poster must be produced in portrait format (landscape is not acceptable).
- Each poster must be produced on material that will easily attach to the poster board with Velcro which you must provide.
- Lamination of posters is recommended, but this is optional.
- > Each poster must include the title, the name of the presenter and author(s), as well as institution.
- Font size at least 16pt must be used anything below this can make it hard to read from a distance.
- > Do not use a dark background.
- Posters will be displayed for the duration of the conference.
- There is no requirement for you to remain with your poster, but you should be available during intervals in order to answer any questions.
- All posters must be removed at the end of the specified day of the conference. If your poster is not taken down at the end of the meeting, it will **NOT** be returned to you.

Enter it in the appropriate field, then enter either the email address where you received the invitation or your first and last names.

TRAVELLING TO NOTTINGHAM

From the north, exit the M1 at junction 26 and follow the signs for the A610 towards Nottingham city centre. There is a Park and Ride (tram) facility situated close to the M1 junction 26. The Park and Ride (Phoenix Park) site is clearly sign-posted off the A610. Leave the tram at the Nottingham Trent University tram stop which is located on Goldsmith Street and walk past the main University entrance, turn left on to Burton Street where you will find the Nottingham Conference Centre entrance. From the south, exit the M1 at junction 24 and follow the signs for the A453 to Nottingham city centre. The Queen's Drive Park and Ride is located just off the A453 (Queen's Drive), follow signs for A453/Queen's Drive Industrial Estate and merge on to the A453 (Queen's Drive). The Park and Ride is located on the opposite side of the road to the retail park and is clearly sign-posted. Alight from the Park and Ride bus on Lower Parliament Street (Victoria Centre); Nottingham Conference Centre is a short walk away.
